



## Training Workshops on **THE MENTAL HEALTHCARE ACT, 2017**

### About the Workshops

The Centre for Mental Health Law & Policy, Pune will conduct two workshops on the implementation of the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 for **mental health professionals, service providers and social workers**. The interactive workshops are designed to provide participants with an in-depth understanding of procedures, compliances and duties of mental health professionals/government authorities under the MHCA.

The workshops will be conducted at the Indian Law Society, Pune by Dr. Soumitra Pathare, Director, Centre for Mental Health Law & Policy. Dr. Pathare is a consultant psychiatrist, and provided technical assistance to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India in drafting the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017.
